Education is a basic human right. Yet hundreds of millions of people in the South, especially women, are deprived of education and advisory services.

Without investment in digital content creation, connectivity is meaningless for the world's poorest people who will find very little information of relevance and almost nothing in their own language.

Access Agriculture hosts over 200 farmer-to-farmer training videos in over 76 languages, offering a unique global service to international development targeting the poorest people on the planet.

To enable rural women and youth to learn, Access Agriculture supports the distribution of videos to rural TV and radio stations, and to farmers directly via mobile phones, SD cards and DVDs. Over the past 20 years, we have learned that:

- Many farmers across Africa, Asia and Latin America face similar challenges;
- Farmers eagerly learn through video from their fellow farmers;
- Farmers like to see how things are done;
- Farmers learn more easily when videos are in their local language.
